Today: York plays its final game of the regular season, looking for a .500 half in the finale at Long Island. York was eliminated from postseason contention yesterday, and is looking to snap a 3-game skid and avoid a sweep.

Last Night: The Revs were shut out for just the third time all season and first time since July 18 (all by Long Island), falling 2-0 in the next-to-last game of the season.

If You're Not First...: Going into Thursday's game, York found itself in sole possession of 1st place for the first time since the end of the 2019 season. York had not even been tied for first since after the second game of the second half. The Revs also reached 2 games above .500 for the first time all season.

Winning Streaks: Prior to Thursday's loss, York set a season-high with a 5-game winning streak (previously won 4 straight, 5x). The Revs had won 8 straight at home, T-3rd longest home streak in club history and longest since a 9-gamer in 2015.

Big Finish: Since the start of September, York has gone 20-16 compared to 35-48 through the first four months of play. The Revs currently hold a +10 run differential in the second half after finishing the first half of the season -42.

Conquering the North: The doubleheader sweep vs SMD on 9/23 featured the final two in a stretch of 30 consecutive North Division games (18-12) for the Revs through 9/23... their final remaining division games after that stretch are this weekend.

War of the Roses: At 13-12, York won the Community Cup for a second straight year; the only other time York won it back-to-back seasons was 2013-14. The Revs have won it for the 7th time in series history compared to 6 Lancaster season series wins and one split. York won 6 straight vs. Lancaster at one point, one shy of the longest winning streak in series history (2010) and the longest since 2014.

Going Long: The Revs have homered in 44 of the last 51 games, totaling 86 HR on that stretch. York has also homered 65 times in the last 38 games and ranks #3 in the league with 155 HR on the season.

Whoa Nelly! Nellie Rodriguez is 4th in the Atlantic League in OBP (.447), 3rd in SLG (.600), and 2nd in OPS (1.047). He ranks T-6th in the league with 24 HR on the season, T-4th in a season in Revs history (Jason Aspito, 2008).

Franc the Tanc: Carlos Franco has 10 HR and 38 RBI in 37 starts since returning from Mexico. He has 56 RBI in just 51 games with the Revs on the season.

Sweep Relief: Prior to a loss in Thursday's home finale, York had swept each of their prev. two home series, both including doubleheader sweeps. York finished 17-11 at PeoplesBank Park in the second half, 32-28 overall, and won 8 of their last 9 home games dating back to September 21st.

York's A-Rod: Alberto Rodriguez leads the league with 53 appearances and over his last 22 outings, has allowed just 7H and 3R/1ER in 20.2 IP, while he has not allowed an earned run in 23 of his last 25 outings (24.2 IP, 3ER, 32K). He has K'd multiple hitters in 10 of those 25 outings.

Fuller House: Jim Fuller leads the league with 28 saves and is the first closer in Revs history to lead the league in saves for a season. His 28 saves rank T-2nd in a season in team history (Rommie Lewis, 2014) and 4th on the Revs career list.

Epic Comebacks: York pulled off an improbable record-setting 12-run comeback in Game 1 Sunday against Gastonia using a season-high 10-run fourth to take a 17-14 lead. That was followed by an 8-run comeback in the 10-9 victory in the nightcap. On 7/13's series opener vs. Lancaster, York scored a then-record 8 runs in the 9th inning for a 13-12 victory. York secured its second biggest overall comeback win of all time erasing a 10-run deficit vs Lancaster in a 13-11 win on July 3rd at PeoplesBank Park.

- **Last start:** ND in York's win vs CWV on Tuesday... 2 of his runs came after his exit in the 6th.
- **7/21 vs. WVP:** Came two outs away from first career 9-inning complete game... gave up two hits with two outs in the first inning before setting down the next 14 batters, facing just four over the minimum in eight innings... left after the Power loaded the bases on him with one out in the 9th... recorded the first out in the 9th on his Revs career high 10th strikeout, four of his first six outs recorded were by strikeout... lone run against him came with Paredes on the mound with bases-loaded walk to Miles Williams, forcing home Connor Myers.
- Walked 4+ in 3 of first 4 starts but had then walked 2 or fewer in 6 straight prior to start 7/27 vs. LEX... 6 walks on 6/3 at LAN tied career-high (8/28/14 with Akron, vs. Trenton; also won that game, allowing just 3 runs in 5.0 IP)... had not walked 4 since 8/11/17 vs Washington (with Joliet) ... has went 6.0 IP or more in 5 of last 6 (including four straight 6/11-6/29)
- Enters 9th pro season, 2nd with York... had also signed with York in 2020.
- 2019 w/ York: 10-7, 3.51, 22GS... was his 3rd career season of 10+ wins (11 in 2013, 10 in 2014) and his first with one club... finished 2nd on team in wins and joined Mitch Atkins to form the league's only duo with 10+ victories... marked 6th time in Revs history and 3rd straight year boasting two 10-game winners... acquired in May via trade from Gary SouthShore for player to be named later.
- Had club record 42.0-inning walkless streak, Aug. 16-Sept. 16, 2019; went 6 full starts without a walk, smashing previous club records of 29.2 IP (Jason Kershner, 2009) and 27.2 IP by a starter (Victor Mateo, 2017)... set club season record issuing just 1.1 BB/9... has issued just 1.87 BB/9 over his career (1.2 in 2018, 1.1 in 2019).
- Originally drafted by LAD (15th rd, 2012) out of Texas Tech University... reached Double-A Chattanooga in each of first three pro seasons
- Traded to CLE 4/6/14 in exchange for fellow Texas Tech product Colt Hynes... reached AAA Columbus for 2 starts that season; also went 8-8 with a 4.20 ERA at Double-A Akron... returned to Akron for 5 starts in 2015... twice named his league's pitcher of the week at Double-A.
- Spent 2016 with Winnipeg (AmAs), going 8-7 with a 4.87 ERA... came to York after two seasons with Joliet (Frontier)... went 5-8 with a 4.06 ERA for the Slammers in 2017, and was 4-1 with a 2.70 ERA in 2018.
- Career: 55-45, 4.15, 145G, 133GS
- Son of former Oklahoma and Miami Dolphins kicker Uwe von Schamann... is half German and a member of the German National Team.
- Majored in education at Texas Tech... member of Big 12 Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll... took medical redshirt in 2010 after undergoing Tommy John surgery prior to season... returned to go 5-0 in 2011 and was named to Big 12 All-Freshman Team... became first Red Raider in over a decade to start career 5-0... lone hit of college career was HR vs Iowa in 2011
- Edmond, OK native... was a 6A All-State selection and All-Edmond Player of the Year as a senior at Edmond Santa Fe HS... played third base in addition to pitching and was quarterback of the football team
- Off-field interests include technology, sports cards, video games, and yoga... got into podcasting during off-season... lists juggling as hidden talent... Oklahoma City Thunder fan.

- 2019 w/ NB: ALPB Closer of the Year, Mid-Season & Post-Season All-Star... 7-2, 1.03, 25SV (T-2nd) in 57G... held opps to .148 avg and final 17G were scoreless... taken by Revs in 1st rd of NB's Dispersal Draft.
- First came to ALPB with LI in 2017 and was acquired by NB in 2018 via trade from Chicago (Amer Assoc)... 37 of 43 apps in 2018 were scoreless including final 15G.
- Has pitched in NYM, MIN, OAK, & PIT orgs... reached AAA in 2015 w/ OAK (Nashville, 2-1, 2.78, 1SV in 28G) and 2016 w/ PIT (Indianapolis, 3G).
