15 Years

The Revs will celebrate their 15th season in 2022. The short franchise history has already seen 3 league championships (2010, 2011, 2017), 8 playoff berths, 11 players reach MLB after their time in York, and 48 players purchased by MLB organizations, and 953 wins

Last Time Out

On Sunday, the Revs got a strong outing from starter Jorge Martinez, who went 4 innings, giving up 3 runs (2 earned) and striking out 6 along the way. They also got their first home run of the season, courtesty of Troy Stokes Jr, who launched a solo HR to left field to tie the game at 4 in the 7th. However, a wild pitch by Johsson Arias in the bottom half and 4 more runs off of Alberto Rodriguez put the Ducks ahead for good as the Revs dropped the rubber game, 9-4

Roster Breakdown

The Revs will open the season with a roster that features 5 players with MLB experience (Gonzalez, Sanabia, Mesa, Stokes Jr, Perez) and 9 that reached Triple A Last season, they opened with 4 players with MLB experience, and finished with 2. The Revs will return 17 players who played in York previously, 16 of whom played last season. They will welcome 13 newcomers who will make their Revs debut this season. It will be split between 15 pitchers and 15 postion players. 3 players will start inactive due to visa issues (RHP Merandy Gonzalez and OFs Melky Mesa and JC Encarnacion)

Schedule Breakdown

The Revs will travel frequently to begin the season, playing 46 of the first 72 away from Peoples Bank Park, and 42 of the final 60 games at home.

Mase Moving Up:

Mark Mason ranks 7th all time in Atlantic League managerial wins with 551, he will pass Brett Jodie (Somerset) and move into 6th all time with 5 more wins. Mason can expect to move into the top 4 early this season, needing just 21 wins to reach that mark

Daddy Shark:

Melky Mesa can move up the ranks in plenty of Revs career categories this season.

Mesa currently holds 65 career multi RBI games, closing in on the record of 71 held by Andres Perez. He enters the year with 172 career starts in left, ranking 2nd all time, and hopes to pass James Shanks for the all time lead at 272. He is 1 HR behind Chase Nowak for 3rd place with 59 HR. With 238 career RBIs, he hopes to become the all time franchise leader this season, passing Andres Perez with 312. He is also already the first player in franchise history to post multiple season hitting .330 or higher (2018, 2021)

2021 MVP Is Back:

Nellie Rodriguez's 2021 was historic by many standards in Revs history. He was the club's only All Star last season. Despite spending a month in the Mexican League, Rodriguez ranked 6th in the league in HR (25), 9th in RBI (81), 3rd in SLG (.603) and 2nd in OPS (1.047). His .444 OBP was a Revs single season record, and 25 HRs is tied for third in a single season. In career marks, he is currently the franchise leader in OBP and SLG

Far From Home:

The Revs will open the season on a 9 game road trip, their longest to open the year since the inaugural season in 2007. They will play the opening weekend in Long Island, followed by a midweek trip to Lexington to face the defending league champs, and the following weekend in Lancaster before the home opener on May 3rd vs Gastonia.

Fuller House:

On Friday, Jim Fuller recorded his 30th career save with York, the fourth in franchise history to acheive the milestone. He now sits 1 behind RJ Rodriguez for 3rd in team history.
